Unless otherwise stated, ties will be resolved in accordance with the rules of the Spanish Federation. These state that for scratch competitions the player with the highest PLAYING handicap will be declared the winner. In the event that there is still a tie, the result will be determined using countback based on the last 9holes,12holes,15holes and 17holes respectively. For net competitions (whether Stableford or Medal), the winner will be the player with the lowest PLAYING handicap. If there is still a tie, the result will be decided by countback as detailed above.
